

Barry Town United Walking Football Chairperson Role

The Barry Town United Walking Football Chairperson is responsible for a range of duties dealing with the overall management of club affairs.

The Barry Town United Walking Football Chairperson leads meetings and sets out a strategic plan for the overall development of the club in the medium to long term.

The Barry Town United Walking Football Chairperson is responsible for upholding the Barry Town United Walking Football constitution and code of conduct and ensuring player welfare is paramount and takes overall charge of driving ongoing participation in the club at all levels.

The duties of the Barry Town United Walking Football Chairperson include, but are not restricted to:

- Overall organisation and running of the club including promotion and club development
- Steering the future direction of principal club matters
- Maintaining a working relationship with the Chairperson of Barry Town United (the parent club)
- Representing the club locally and nationally.
- Chairing meetings including regular committee meetings and the club AGM
- Strategic planning and key decision-making duties with relevant members of Barry Town United Walking Football committee
- Upholding the Barry Town United Walking Football Constitution and Code of Conduct
- Delegating, leading and motivating club volunteers towards club goals and objectives
- Following advice from the Barry Town United Walking Football Treasurer, contacting members whose membership fees are in arrears to pay club membership due.
- Chairing disciplinary meetings and advising the Chairperson of Barry Town United of any incidents that might impact on the parent club
- From time to time, other duties as agreed by the Barry Town United Walking Football Committee
