The Barry Town United Walking Football Player Representative plays a crucial role in bridging communication between the players and the club's committee.

The Barry Town United Walking Football Player Representative is responsible for upholding the Barry Town United Walking Football constitution and code of conduct and ensuring player welfare is paramount.

The duties of the Barry Town United Walking Football Players Representative include, but are not restricted to:

- Acting as the first point of contact for any player concerns, understanding the importance of confidentiality
- Acting as the voice of the players in meetings with the Barry Town United Walking Football committee, ensuring their concerns and suggestions are heard.
- Ensuring that players' conduct aligns with the club's standards and expectations.
- Assisting the coach with training sessions and other team-related duties
- Fostering a supportive and friendly environment.
- Helping to recruit new players and volunteers for the club.
- Implementing the club's policies and procedure.
- Facilitating adult welfare training
- Maintaining up to date knowledge of the walking football governing body's protection guidance
- Upholding the Barry Town United Walking Football Constitution and Code of Conduct
- From time to time, other duties as agreed by the Barry Town United Walking Football Committee
